

Primary PE Sports Grant 2016/17

Impact Report

St John the Baptist Catholic Primary School Dartmouth

This report outlines the impact of the Primary PE sports grant. The impact can be seen as increased pupil participation in sport and sporting activities, increased awareness of a healthy lifestyle and well-being, increased opportunities to participate in primary sport as well as opportunities to try new sports, increased participation in intra-school sports and competitions with other schools and a wide and varied PE curriculum supported by experienced and trained teacher.

Actions/Activities/Resources	Cost	Impact
Providing Professional Coaches for after school and lunch time clubs and P E Provision	£5,810	Children exposed to a variety of sports and physical activities and in increased participation and enthusiasm in PE lesson. Children are able to participate in an increasing number of clubs. Children taking part in physical activity as well as recognising the importance of a healthy, balanced diet. Links made with local clubs and academies so provision is continued outside of school.

Purchasing of Equipment and storage	£770	PE lessons now well-resourced ensuring good quality PE lessons to take place. A wider variety of sports equipment linked to learning of new sports with equipment being replaced as required.
Tournaments/Competitions	£409	An increased number of pupils able to take part in tournaments with other schools. Ability to travel to sports competitions. Success in tournaments due to expert coaching.
Administration	£500	PE co-ordinator being released from classroom in order to monitor PE lessons throughout the school and provide feedback to staff.
