

Performance data for 2015 - 2016

Foundation Stage – (14 pupils)

71% reached a Good Level of Development(11 out of 14 pupils). A Good Level of Development is the expected standard at Foundation stage. 93% of pupils made expected or better progress from their relative starting points.

Year 1- Phonics screening(9 pupils)89%(8 out of 9) of pupils passed the phonic screening test. 2 pupils from Year 2 retook the test and passed.
